**Re: St. Kilda Beach Rally of 5 January 2019**

Prime Minister, I take issue with your comments regarding the protesters at the St. Kilda right-wing organised anti-crime rally. This rally was held on Saturday 5 January 2019. Your comments that the attendees are far-right and racists is an insult to the grandparents and parents who attended. Your comments are also an insult to the many victims of crime who attended the rally.

Just because people like myself attended this rally does not make us racists or far-right. Most people attended the rally because we are in a lot of trouble in Melbourne with violent crime such as home invasions, business invasions, carjacking's, and assaults escalating. I know that I and many others attended the rally to highlight to our political masters by way of peaceful action how bad the African crime wave is in the State of Victoria, especially in Melbourne. This does not make us racist. Like others who attended the rally, I have an issue with violent crime not being dealt with by the Victorian government, the judicial system, Police Command, and the Federal government. That is why I attended.

In the state of Victoria, we have 'soft on crime' policies, a lenient judicial system, and a Police Command which is nothing but a mouth piece for state government policies.

The majority of home invasions, business invasions, carjacking's and assaults are carried out by youth crime gangs. Within these youth crime gangs, the South Sudanese youth are overly represented in the numbers. That is not racist; it is reality.

I am 61, married with two children. It was the first time I have ever attended a right-wing and counter left-wing protest rally. I am not a member of any right or left-wing group. I'm not a member of any political party. I'm what is referred to as a 'swinging voter,' in that I have no political allegiance to any political party or politician. For you to label me far-right and racist as you have done in your comments means you have lost my vote at this year's federal election.

At no stage did I hear any far-right comments or racists comments made by any of the speakers at the right wing rally. I did hear some from the left-wing groups who attended. In fact, the first arrest conducted by VicPOL was of a left-wing person who had a pocket full of fishing sinkers. He was throwing these sinkers at the Police and right-wing people. I am led to believe there were only three arrests all afternoon. This is hardly the giant brawl that the media made it out to be.

Prime Minister you have given the perception that innocent people and victims of crime who stand up against violent African crime are 'ugly racists' and far-right. While you may think that African crime gangs are nothing for Victorians to worry about, I can assure you it is very much something for us Victorians to worry about, and we do. I am led to believe that this African violent crime problem is spreading into other states in Australia.


Are you aware we now have 'no-go' zones in Melbourne? There are parks where people can't take their children to in the daytime, let alone at night time. There are many people in suburbs of Melbourne who are scared to go out at night. Are you aware that victims are beginning to be tortured by these gangs, even after the gang has got what it wanted?

In Melbourne, we suffer daily attacks from African gangs during home invasions, business invasions, carjacking's, and assaults. In these violent attacks, the offenders use machetes, knives, lengths of pipe, and rocks to carve up and bash their helpless victims. They pull pregnant women from their cars at traffic lights and bash them before stealing their cars. In the state of Victoria, children go to school and urinate and/or defecate in their cloths because they are traumatised from watching their parents being assaulted.

In most of these attacks, white women are referred to as whores, white sluts, and the only thing white women want is a big black penis up their bottoms. In some of these attacks, young children are threatened with rape. You should have your office staff check the numbers on the

amount of people in Victorian mental health hospitals or in the care of psychiatrists and psychologists because of the violent trauma they have suffered during an African gang attack. Our children on their way home from school are attacked by African gangs for their mobile phones. Lately, it has been the Vietnamese café and restaurant owners who have brutally assaulted by these thugs.

Interestingly, African gangs do not attack other African homes or African people in Victoria. I would argue that it is the Africans who are racist. Yet, you and your colleagues do not call out these people. Why is that?

The speakers at the rally highlighted where most of the violent crime is coming from. As a person who is known in Victoria for writing about the injuries suffered by the victims of crime, I can 100% guarantee you that the speakers were accurate. You are not a racist if you say, 'African crime'.

Prime Minister, you were way out of line with your comments. Let's be honest; if you politicians fixed our escalating violent African crime problem, we wouldn't have to protest.

You and your government have deserted us in Victoria, as has the current State government of Victoria has done. You will not address our safety and security concerns. Therefore, we have to highlight the issues in hope that someone will help us. Hopefully, a new political party will rise up which will place dealing with violent crime at the top of their agenda.

In reference to Saturday 5 January rally, all you have done Prime Minister is view some heavily edited TV footage in the media which exaggerated a few instances of bad behaviour. Sadly, you believed it.

The area on St. Kilda beach which was chosen by the protest rally organisers was so chosen because it was the same spot where 200 African youths rioted and assaulted white people last year. No arrests were made by the Police. You also need to remember that some of these assaults are so brutal by the offenders that victims come very close to dying. In one case I know of personally, two white brothers were attacked at night by a Sudanese gang. One of the white people had their throat slit with a machete and died. The other white guy spent a long time in hospital recovering from his injuries. This case will be before the courts in February of this year.

Also, the rally site on St. Kilda beach was chosen by the protest rally organisers as it was the same spot where a few weeks ago African thugs attacked white beach goers, assaulting them and stealing their wallets, mobile phones and purses. Once again, no arrests were made.

Instead of belittling victims of violent African crime and their families by calling them racist and far-right, how about you have some sympathy for the victims. Once again, I will state that the reason there is so much violent escalating African crime is because you politicians have no interest in protecting the Victorian people.

When I arrived at the venue, it was plain for all to see that the Police had put a wide distance between the two opposing groups. There were about 200 to 250 right-wing people and a similar number of left-wing people. There was a large number of Police in attendance. Well done to the Police for saturating the area. But, I must admit, I didn't know Victoria had so many Police Officers. I'd sure like to know where they all are when the African youths riot on St. Kilda beach and beat people up while stealing their valuables. You never see the Police on St. Kilda beach then. Nor do you see the Police when the African youths go about beating up the wonderful Vietnamese store and restaurant owners, or when the African youth are rioting in Taylors Hill and in Collingwood.

After the rally, I was sitting in a Café, having a beer, and I noticed two African men and two African women walk past the right-wing people who were hanging around the area. The Africans were clearly attempting to incite some form of retaliation against them, but the right-wing people ignored them. Well done to them. This is hardly the far-right, racist, violent people you make them out to be.

I then left the area. As I was leaving, I did see some right-wing people and left-wing people arguing across the Police lines. They were yelling at one another. There is no way they could have got close enough to each other to brawl. Well done to the Police.

The above is what I saw, and what the media is attempting to portray is designed to give the impression that a giant brawl between left-wing and right-wing groups occurred. No such brawl occurred. It is false reporting. Instead of you politicians believing the media, then coming out in some media outlets and bagging the people who are concerned about the high levels of crime, you should turn off the bullshit media who exaggerate isolated incidences and talk to the people. In this case, talk to the people who attended the rally. That way you will get the truth.

The perception Prime Minister you are giving the Victorian people is that you support the African crime wave sweeping our state and you do not support the people who are highlighting how bad the problem is, and you also give a perception that you care nothing for the victims. You are already on the nose in Victoria, and I fear now as you have deserted us, you will be on the nose even more.
